- Raises issues on behalf of GMB members
- Keeps GMB members up to date with info from GMB
- Advises and helps GMB members with any issues
- Represents GMB members in the workplace in meetings
- · Helps to ensure the voice of support staff is heard in schools

- Job Evaluation
- Additional Hours
- Overtime
- Self Isolating
- Sick Pay





# **HOW CAN ISSUES BE ADDRESSED?**

#### **INFORMALLY**



- by talking about the issue and seeing if a mutually agreeable solution can be found
- by sending an email, setting out the issue or concerns stating it is hoped the matters can be resolved informally

#### **FORMALLY**

by raising a collective grievance
